AGRICULTURE EVENTS & FESTIVALS

January

Farm Show, Quad Cities—Thousands of farmers gather for three days in the Quad Cities to discover products and services offered from vendors.

Northern Illinois Farm Show, DeKalb, Illinois— With over 5,000 attendees and 200 local and leading exhibitors, the IDEAg Northern Illinois Farm Show is a convenient venue for producers in northern Illinois, southern Wisconsin and eastern lowa to meet with agribusinesses under one roof. The show will feature a multitude of highly informative and strong educational programs developed by the University of Illinois Extension Services.

Iowa Pork Congress, Des Moines, IA—This annual event brings together attendees and exhibitors working with swine to learn, network and discover new products.

February

Iowa Beef Expo, Des Moines, Iowa— The Iowa Beef Expo is an annual event held mid-February bringing together farmers, buyers and sellers for a full week of networking, shows, and a free expo.

Illinois Beef Expo, Springfield, IL— This annual event is the last full weekend of February at the Illinois State Fairground in Springfield. One of the premier cattle events of the Midwest, the event hosts multiple sales, a junior show for Illinois exhibitors, and a large industry trade show.

July

Historic Farm Days, Penfield, IL— Located in Penfield, Illinois this yearly event of farm festivities include, tractor pulls, collector edition tractors, daily parades, fireworks, food & more!

August

Half-Century of Farm Progress
